# Worship Service Update

We will be worshipping <u>online</u> <u>only</u> through the month of August. After looking at the Governor's Executive Order, the current positive percentage in testing, the age of those attending and the increasing difficulty in having the necessary volunteers to run our services, we concluded that we will continue with online services only.

We will continue livestreaming a Traditional Worship Service at 8:30 am and a Contemporary Worship Service at 10:00 am each Sunday. At the conclusion of each service, it will be archived on our website and available at any time for viewing.

Drive-Thru Communion will be from 11:15 am -12:15 pm on Sunday, August 2 and 16.

I know that many of you yearn to be with fellow believers in worship so I suggest, if you feel comfortable, inviting a few friends over for worship and a time of fellowship. If you do this wearing a mask you would be following the guidelines that have been given to us and still enjoying worship with fellow believers.

  - o Classrooms and Youth Rooms are painted

  - o Insulation and drywall are being installed in the Worship Center
  - o Grading has begun for the new parking around the TPC
  - o SRP has installed their junction box and transformer
  - o Fiber is in the process of being run between the three buildings.
  - o Exterior doors are being installed
  - o Roof over the lobby is completed
  - o Exterior cross has been assembled and painted
- The next 30 days
  - o Concrete for the raised seating in the worship center will be poured
  - o Exterior EFIS completed
  - o Parking around the TPC finished
  - o Feature Wall behind the platform completed
  - o Grading of the north property might begin

# Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

Our Sunday morning Ministry Partner positions are scheduled through Planning Center. We are using a tool in Planning Center called "Sign-up-Sheets". Rather than the office scheduling, now you will be able to choose which Sundays/services you'd like to serve.

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

We know that some of our married couples that use Planning Center share the same email address. If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.

# Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

The following is a summary of financial activity for Risen Savior Lutheran Church. If you would like more detailed reports, please contact our Business Manager, Susan Mello at susan.mello@rslcs.org.

#### Did you know?

The Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) is a loan program that originated from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. This program is intended to provide American small businesses with cash-flow assistance through 100% federally guaranteed loans backed by the Small Business Administration (SBA) and if certain conditions are met, will be up to 100% forgivable. On May 1, 2020, Risen Savior Lutheran Church received a PPP loan in the amount of \$325,422. This represented 2.5 times the amount of our monthly payroll costs and can be used to cover payroll costs, mortgage interest payments and utility payments as needed for a period up to 24 weeks. Based on the June 19, 2020 PPP Flexibility Loan Forgiveness Interim Final rule, we are confident that the PPP loan for Risen Savior will be 100% forgiven.

This loan will be instrumental in limiting the financial impact of the Coronavirus Pandemic. Please note, until we have received forgiveness for the loan, the financial impact will not be presented in the financials. The SBA is in the final stages of developing the Forgiveness Process for lenders to administer. We have been in contact with our lender weekly for updates on when we will be able to apply for loan forgiveness.

#### Financial Summary for June 2020:

Below, you will see detail for June financials. Please note that these results <u>do not</u> reflect the impact of our Paycheck Protection Loan.

#### **Giving Results**

Giving was *over* budget by \$4,160 for the month of June and *under* budget by (\$43,609) CYTD20. This is an amazing blessing to the ministry of Risen Savior. Thank You!

For CYTD20, we are at 95% of the budget for Giving. The shortfall is predominantly in Loose Plate Giving.

#### Spending

Spending was *under* budget by (\$17,837) for the month of June and *under* budget by (\$97,576) CYTD20.

In light of the decrease in Giving and Preschool Revenue, we continue to monitor expenses and limit based on necessity.

#### Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *under* budget by (\$552) for the month of June and *under* budget (\$125,904) CYTD20.

While our summer Preschool attendance was down, beginning August 3, 2020, attendance is estimated to be at 75% of pre-pandemic levels.

Due to public schools offering online only to begin the school year, the Preschool is offering a K -3 mentoring program where students come to the center and receive assistance with online school as well as childcare. *This is a temporary program*.

#### Net Operating Cash

As of June 30, 2020, Operating Cash is a *negative* (\$108,523) which is a decrease of (\$62,701) from the end of May.

Please note that this does NOT include the impact of the PPP Loan.

This is significantly below our budgeted position for this time of the year, but we are putting controls in place to limit the effect of this through the end of the calendar year.
