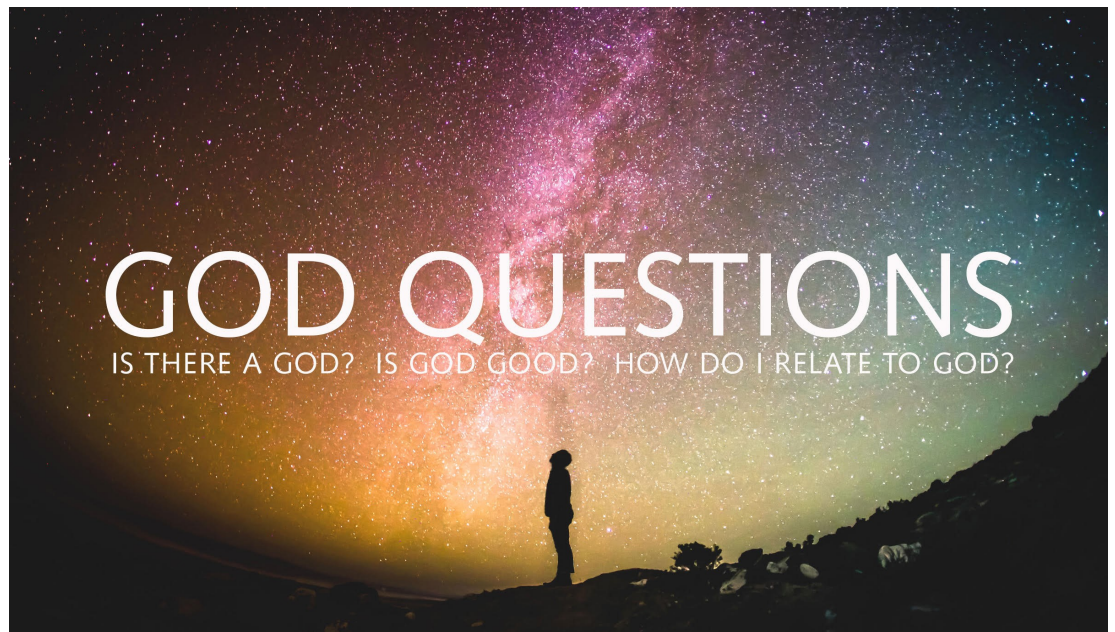

Sunday "Ministry Partner" Sign-up Process

Our Sunday morning Ministry Partner positions are scheduled through Planning Center. We are using a tool in Planning Center called "Sign-up-Sheets". Rather than the office scheduling, now you will be able to choose which Sundays/services you'd like to serve.

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

We know that some of our married couples that use Planning Center share the same email address. If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at <https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com>. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.

Feeling Cold During Service on Sunday? Borrow a Shawl



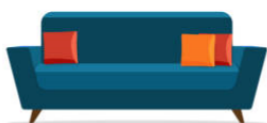
Now Available at All of the Services.

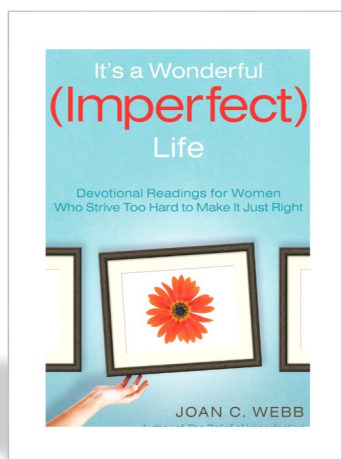

Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

Did you know?

Since the beginning of the Our Next Step... Campaign,
over \$1million of the \$4,200,000 pledged has been received.

Thank you to Risen Savior for your generosity. These gifts that are above and beyond your regular tithing and will help ensure the success of our Ministry Expansion.

Financial Summary for June 2019 and Fiscal Year End 2019:

Giving Results

Giving was **under** budget by (\$111,821) for the month of June and **under** budget by (\$137,311) for FYE2019. There are a few factors impacting the Giving for FY2019:

Some Giving has switched from General Fund to Our Next Step...

The impact of the new tax laws on Giving is uncertain. In addition, many individuals are utilizing Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) as their General Fund giving. Risen Savior typically receives a lump sum distribution for a calendar year rather than the fiscal year. This can skew the numbers for our fiscal year.

Switching to a Calendar Year format would alleviate this.

We did not do a Pledge series for General Fund this year. This did have an impact on General Fund Giving.

Spending

Spending was **under** budget by (\$20,772) in June and **under** budget by (\$338,525) for FYE2019.

Church payroll and benefits are under budget as both the DCE and Associate Pastor positions were budgeted for a full year. The Associate Pastor position was not filled and DCE expenses were for only one month of the fiscal year.

Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was **under** budget by (\$2,742) in June and **over** budget by \$13,039 for FYE2019.

While Preschool tuition was **under** budget by (\$126,000) due to closing the Infant Room, expenses were also **under** budget by \$139,000.

Net Operating Cash

As of June 30, 2019 and FYE19, Operating Cash is a **positive** of \$68,225 which is a **decrease** of (\$37,034) from May.

The Governing Board will vote on the disposition of the positive Operating Cash.
