

The COVID-19 Pandemic appeared unexpectedly, so not everyone was prepared to manage a situation like this. This created a lot of challenges for each one of us, but even more for the Carepoints and the community leaders. At some point, we can have fear and freeze or we can become an overcomer.

All of this began March 13 in Guatemala where, due to COVID-19, schools closed, total lockdown and social distancing. La Cuchilla Carepoint became an overcomer by delivering to 125 families with food bags, facemasks and hand soap to the families to help them stay healthy and safe during this time.

Most people at La Cuchilla have seasonal jobs in plantations, work in construction or have informal jobs in order to sustain themselves. With the COVID-19 Pandemic, La Cuchilla and the communities around are in a really difficult situation, because they cannot go to their jobs at the fields or markets to

sell. The government has put in place some programs to support those families with the most need in the country, by giving out food bags through the public schools and some of the families have received this support, however, there are some families not meeting the requirements in order to receive the help.

Because of what we have described, delinquency increased in these communities, people started to force homes and public institutions to get some food or articles to sell in the streets to get money. In May, someone broke into the school at La Cuchilla, but thankfully the neighbors of the school scared him away. He came into the back of the school through the rubber tree plantation. It was just a day before distributing food bags for the families of the community. We were able to see the hand of God protecting the school and using the people around to scare this person. This is not the first time this has happened and now that the CarePoint will start at the school building, we see the need to increase the security around the building. By doing this, the children and any supplies at the Carepoint stay safe specially once everything opens and we get back to a normal way of operating.

You can join us praying for:

- The families at La Cuchilla and their financial situation. - the Carepoint leadership health every time they buy and distribute the food bags for the community. - For the children's safety and good care at home during quarantine. - For the security of the school.

Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

The following is a summary of financial activity for Risen Savior Lutheran Church. If you would like more detailed reports, please contact our Business Manager, Susan Mello at susan.mello@rslcs.org.

Did you know?

The Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) is a loan program that originated from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. This program is intended to provide American small businesses with cash-flow assistance through 100% federally guaranteed loans backed by the Small Business Administration (SBA) and if certain conditions are met, will be up to 100% forgivable. On May 1, 2020, Risen Savior Lutheran Church received a PPP loan in the amount of \$325,422. This represented 2.5 times the amount of our monthly payroll costs and can be used to cover payroll costs, mortgage interest payments and utility payments as needed for a period up to 24 weeks. Based on the June 19, 2020 PPP Flexibility Loan Forgiveness Interim Final rule, we are confident that the PPP loan for Risen Savior will be 100% forgiven.

This loan will be instrumental in limiting the financial impact of the Coronavirus Pandemic. Please note, until we have received forgiveness for the loan, the financial impact will not be presented in the financials. We estimate forgiveness to occur not later than the end of October 2020.

Financial Summary for May 2020:

Below, you will see detail for May financials. Please note that these results do not reflect the impact of our Paycheck Protection Loan.

Giving Results

Giving was *under* budget by (\$6,931) for the month of May and *under* budget by (\$46,719) CYTD20. For CYTD20, we are at 93% of the budget for Giving. The shortfall is predominantly in Loose Plate giving.

Spending

Spending was *under* budget by (\$4,407) for the month of May and *under* budget by (\$79,234) CYTD20.

In light of the decrease in Giving, we continue to monitor expenses and limit based on necessity. Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *under* budget by (\$34,260) for the month of May and *under* budget (\$125,352) CYTD20.

Preschool attendance is down considerably due to the recent increase in COVID positive tests. We are evaluating this trend and determining next steps.

Below is a summary of what has occurred with the Preschool recently:

The Preschool closed on March 16, 2020 due to concerns for Teacher and Student safety due to the COVID outbreak.

The Preschool reopened on May 4, 2020 at approximately 35% of the pre-Coronavirus attendance.

Our Preschool has been deemed a DES Enrichment Center which provides paid childcare for Essential Workers in exchange for us practicing pandemic health and safety protocols.

Net Operating Cash

As of May 31,2020, Operating Cash is a *negative* (\$45,822) which is a decrease of (\$75,338) from the end of April.

Please note that this does NOT include the impact of the PPP Loan.

This is significantly below our budgeted position for this time of the year, but we are putting controls in place to limit the effect of this through the end of the calendar year.
