# 50 Families Needed—Friendship Family Program

Can you imagine arriving in a foreign country not knowing anyone, being lonely, missing your family and having limited knowledge of the new culture? That is exactly what happens to the over 1,500 new international students arriving at the ASU, Tempe campus each Fall. Lutheran Ministry at ASU has been granted a wonderful opportunity to partner with ASU's International Student and Scholars Center (ISSC) for

the Friendship Family Program. The Friendship Family Program connects ASU international students with local "Friends" with the hopes of developing friendships, getting students more involved in their local communities and encouraging a cross-cultural exchange through friendship. The program strives to enrich the lives of both the student and "friends" in as many ways as possible. "Friends" and students mutually decide what kinds of interactions and activities they want to do together, as well as the frequency of meeting that works out best for everyone involved. With your help there are two important statistics that we will strive to address. First, 75% of international students are never invited into an American home and second, 80% of international students never go to a church while living in the United States. At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. Remember, if you share an email address with another Planning Center user, you must keep track of which account you're accessing when you are signing up or making changes to your schedule.



#### Did you know?

Since the beginning of the Our Next Step... Campaign,

over \$1million of the \$4,200,000 pledged has been received.

Thank you to Risen Savior for your generosity. These gifts that are above and beyond your regular tithing will help to ensure the success of our Ministry Expansion.

#### Financial Summary for May 2019:

#### **Giving Results**

Giving was *under* budget by (\$13,994) for the month of May and *under* budget by (\$125,490) for FYTD2019.

Weekly giving is flat compared to the same time last year.

Some donors have shifted giving from General Fund to Capital Campaign.

#### Spending

Spending was *under* budget by (\$20,686) in May and *under* budget by (\$317,217) for FYTD2019.

Church payroll and benefits are under budget as both the DCE and Associate Pastor positions were budgeted for a full year and have not been filled yet.

#### Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *over* budget by \$10,687 in May and *over* budget by \$6,590 for FYTD2019.

The Preschool is now at budgeted levels of enrollment.

#### Net Operating Cash

As of May 30, 2019, Operating Cash is a *positive* of \$105,259, which is a *decrease* of (\$4,641) from March.

We to end the fiscal year with a positive Operating Cash.
