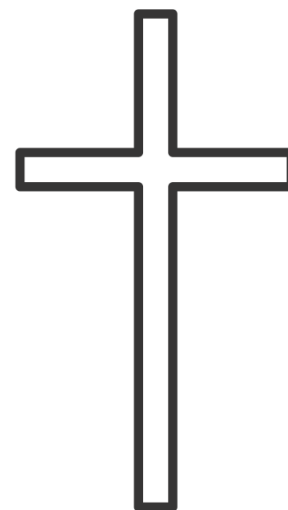

BUILDING UPDATE

The footers for the new building have been poured. Footers are concrete slabs that go deep in the ground. The main structural beams are then anchored to the footers to keep the building stable. In the next few weeks, the plumbing pipes and the conduit for electrical will be run through the slab floor. In early December, the concrete slab will be poured, which is when we will put the prayer cards, that were filled out by the congregation, under the Worship Center floor.

The large tanks for the underground water retention have arrived and they will be installed in the coming weeks. This is part of the prep work for the parking lot to be laid at a future date.

The Pathway Center Building Update



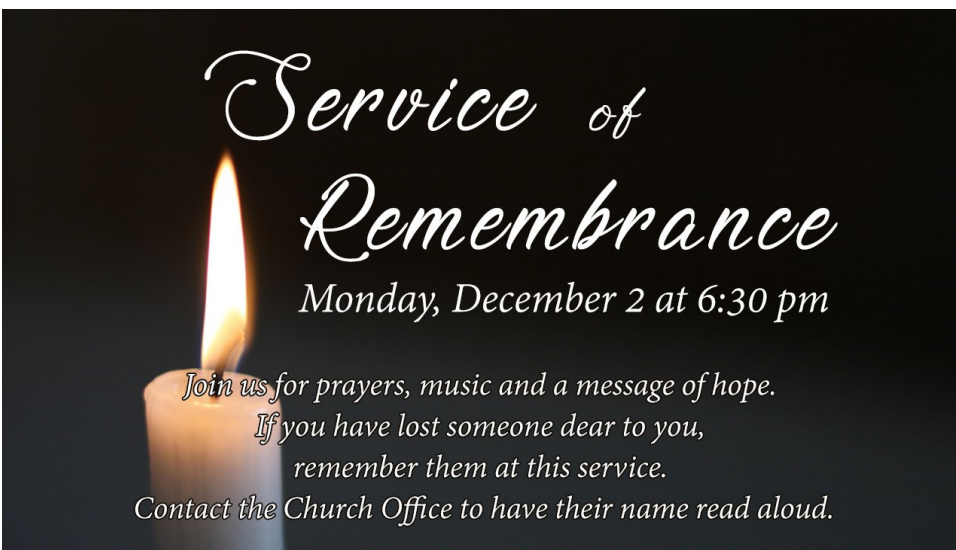

Guatemala Friendship Ministry – La Cuchilla Carepoint

What is a HopeChest Carepoint?

A Carepoint is a foreign community with a high population of vulnerable children. The Carepoint becomes an extension of our church team to form a true community-to-community partnership. Recognizing that God created us for community because, we are not built to go through life alone. We can be better together!

La Cuchilla is a small village in the Suchitepéquez Department of the southwestern region of Guatemala. This small village has a particularity, since it is between two main municipalities it does not receive any help from either for the community. This CarePoint (CP) is a Public School. The school staff, Parent's Committee and the Local Community Government are involved in helping the children to have a better future.

Cases of malnourishment or stunting are not uncommon among children attending the local elementary school. The main reason for this is the work situation of the parents in the community. Usually children eat one to two times a day, but not very nutritious meals. The dropout rate is 97%, that is, of every 100 children who begin Elementary School, only 31 continue into Middle School and only 3 finish High School.

Recognizing the multitude of challenges confronting children in La Cuchilla, Children's HopeChest will implement the Model Village, which assumes a holistic approach when serving them, incorporating initiatives into its programming, which could span the following sectors.

- **Discipleship:** Teach practical areas of life such as identity, health, community and economics, all of which are based on Biblical principles so that each child recognizes their own responsibility in seeking a life of integral abundance.
- **Nutrition:** Ensure that children receive a nutritious breakfast, initially three times per week at the beginning of school, to fortify the diet of students and thereby, improve their learning and school performance.
- **Education:** To integrate the parents in the educational progress. The intention is to complete the educational triangle: School and students with parents. Help with the education of the children attending the program reinforcing subjects like Math, Spanish, Science and Social Studies.
- **Health:** The main purpose of this program is to improve the quality of the health and nutrition of the children attending the CP. It will increase their attention span in class and their school learning. The main reason for economic empowerment projects is to enhance self-sustainability. We want to implement:
 - **Vegetable garden:** Help the CP grow their own vegetables to support the nutritional program and at the same time generate extra income to invest into the CP.
 - **Chicken Coops:** We plan to educate families and the community on sustainable food systems. Chickens provide an important learning opportunity both in terms of caring for livestock and further closing the "ecological loop" of the garden at school. Eventually, the chickens will also provide eggs for the CP and the community.
 - **Kitchen:** Building a kitchen will help the school to have an adequate place near the CP to cook and serve food.

We expect a negative Operating Cash in the first few months of the fiscal year due to the timing of receipts and disbursements.

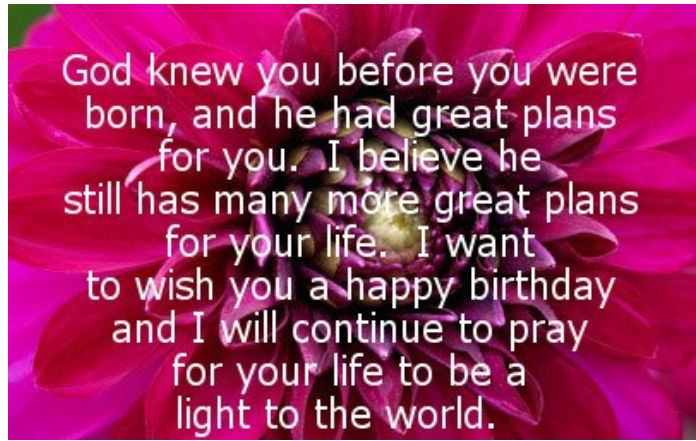

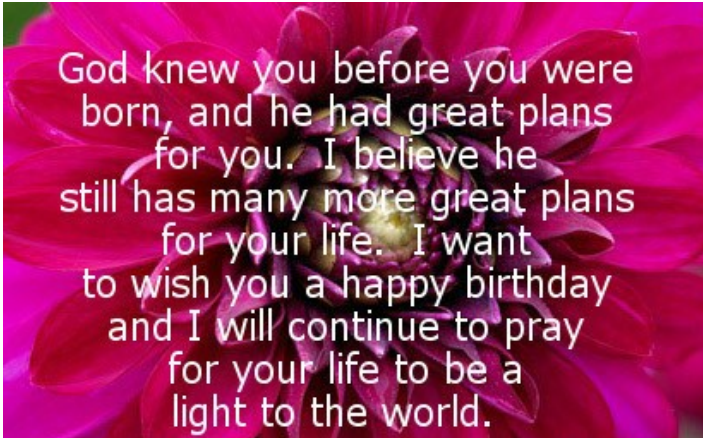
