

Sunday Ministry Partner Sign-up Process

At the beginning of each month you will receive an email asking you to select which Sundays you would like to serve. These dates will be saved in your Planning Center account and you'll receive reminder emails as the date approaches.

If you do, here's what we need ONE of you to do: (One of you may keep your current password, but the other needs to create a new one). Enter the link to get to the sign-in page of Planning Center at https://accounts.planningcenteronline.com. Type in your email address and click the checkmark button. 

Risen Savior Monthly Financial Review

The following is a summary of financial activity for Risen Savior Lutheran Church. If you would like more detailed reports, please contact our Business Manager, Susan Mello at susan.mello@rslcs.org.

Did you know?

For the months of June and July, Giving was above budget. This is such a blessing for the Ministry of Risen Savior and we are so thankful for your continued support.

We are still feeling the effects of COVID19 with overall Church receipts down just over \$50,000 for the calendar year-to-date. This is due to missing the Giving budget in March, April and May combined with lost receipts from the Bridge Club. In exercising good stewardship of what God has blessed us with, we continue to monitor our expenses and have underspent our Operating Budget which has given us a solid financial position and allowed us to support our Mission Organizations that are also facing the same decrease in receipts during this pandemic. We want to continue to bless these Missions and have pledged to meet and in most areas exceed our commitment for the year. Your continued support of the Ministries of Risen Savior has allowed us to do that.

Financial Summary for July 2020:

Below, you will see the detail for July financials. Please note that these results do not reflect the impact of our Paycheck Protection Loan.

Giving Results

Giving was *over* budget by \$5,913 for the month of July and *under* budget by (\$37,696) CYTD20. For CYTD20, we are at 96% of the budget for Giving. The shortfall is predominantly in Loose Plate giving.

Spending

Spending was *under* budget by (\$31,273) for the month of July and *under* budget by (\$128,849) CYTD20.

The Preschool has underspent due to control over variable costs such as food and labor that has been impacted by lower enrollment.

The Church has put controls in place to monitor expenses and adjust as needed based on Giving. In light of the decrease in Giving and Preschool Revenue, we continue to monitor expenses and limit based on necessity.

Preschool and Kindergarten (PS&K)

PS&K Net Income was *over* budget by \$11,611 for the month of July and *under* budget (\$114,294) CYTD20.

Current enrollment at the Preschool is approximately 75% of the pre-COVID19 levels.

Due to public schools offering online only to begin the school year, the Preschool is offering a K-3 mentoring program where students come to the Center and receive assistance with online school as well as childcare. This program has been highly successful with as many as 17 children attending.

Net Operating Cash

As of July 31, 2020, Operating Cash is a *negative* (\$105,042) which is an increase of \$3,481 from the end of June.

Please note that this does NOT include the impact of the PPP Loan.

This is significantly below our budgeted position for this time of the year, but we are putting controls in place to limit the effect of this through the end of the calendar year.
