

# 4TH & 5TH GRADE

## THE CROWD WELCOMES JESUS

- -BASED ON MATTHEW 21:1-11
- Jesus and the disciples were traveling to Jerusalem. They came to the city of Bethphage at the Mount of Olives.
- Jesus sent two of the disciples into the village. He told the disciples they would see a donkey tied up with her colt. Jesus told them to untie the donkey and colt and bring them to Him. Jesus explained if anyone asked why they were taking the donkey and colt, the disciples were to tell them the Lord needs them.
- Zechariah the prophet had written this would happen. He said, "See, your King is coming to you, gentle, and mounted on a donkey, and on a colt."
- The disciples did just as Jesus had instructed. The disciples laid their clothes on the donkey and colt, and Jesus sat on them.
- A very large crowd of people spread their clothes on the road. Other people cut branches from trees to spread on the road. The crowds went ahead of Jesus and some followed Him. The people cried out: "Hosanna (pause) to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna (pause) in the highest heaven!"
- As Jesus came into Jerusalem, the whole city was excited. People were asking who that was riding into the city. The crowds answered, "This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee.

# The Crowd Welcomed Jesus

#### **MATTHEW 21:1-11**

Jesus was traveling with His disciples to Jerusalem. As He came to the Mount of Olives outside a village called Bethphage, Jesus instructed two of the disciples to go into the village where they would find a donkey tied with a colt. Jesus told the disciples to untie the animals and bring them to Him. He told the men that if anyone



asked what they were doing, they should say that the Lord needs the animals.

This happened to fulfill a prophecy (word of God) that was written hundreds of years before. This prophecy said, "Look! Your King is coming, riding on a young donkey."

The disciples followed Jesus' instructions. They brought the donkey and the colt, put their robes on them, and Jesus sat on top of them.

As Jesus rode, a large crowd of people spread their robes on the road. Others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road, too. Crowds of people went in front of Him and followed after Him. They shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up and asked, "Who is this?"

The crowd replied, "This is Jesus from Nazareth of Galilee."
