- Pray. Thank God for loving us and sending His Son, Jesus. Offer boys and girls opportunities to pray, too.

MAKE A BANNER

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- KIDS ACTIVITY PAGE
- LONG PIECE OF CRAFT PAPER
- MARKER
- CRAYONS
- STICKERS
- TEMPERA PAINTS
- PAINTING SHIRT
- On a long piece of craft paper, print the word Hosanna. Guide children to wear smocks if using paint.
- Guide children to complete the Kids Activity
 Pages.
- Point to the word spelled out on the banner and invite children to say it with you. Remind children that when people welcomed Jesus, they shouted Hosanna!
- Invite children to decorate the banner using the provided art supplies. They may want to print other welcome words or draw pictures and designs. Say the Life Point: "God sent Jesus because He loves us." Open the Bible to 1 John 4:10 and read "God loved us and sent His Son."


